Procedure of notifying to the classification and labeling inventory according to the CLP Regulation Articles 39-42 of the Würth Group

Dear Mrs. / Mr.

We refer to our letter of July 15th 2010 regarding the CLP Regulation Articles 39-42. In this letter we asked our non-EU suppliers to confirm that the notification to the classification and labeling inventory was carried out successfully. Unfortunately, the return of these confirmations was very poor and therefore we would like to assist you in this matter and show you the approach of one of our suppliers.

Our Würth-subsidiaries must be able to rely upon the fact that your OR (Only Representative) has carried out the notification to the classification and labeling inventory. Otherwise our subsidiaries are not authorized to carry on selling the products and Würth will have to block the goods. In collaboration with the OR of our supplier Kisling and our Service Provider TechniData, we have carried out a group notification. This approach has been confirmed by ECHA to be correct. We want for you to assume this approach as well and have your OR notify all your products, for all our EU-national companies, in the form of a group notification.

Furthermore, we ask you to send us the contact details of your OR, so that our EU-national companies can contact the OR directly and report the annual quantity sold.

When you have made sure that the notification is carried out we ask you to send us the corresponding confirmations, per each EU-national company, until March 31* 2011. We will then forward the documents to our subsidiaries in order for them to be able to show these in case of an inspection by the authorities.
